The Max Gardner Award for Distinguished Service will be given by PCFA to an individual or organisation that has made an outstanding and significant contribution to the cause of prostate cancer in Australia.

The definition of an outstanding and significant contribution would include, but not be limited, to:

1. a contribution through which the cause of prostate cancer has been substantially, demonstrably and positively changed
2. a contribution that has occurred over a significant period of time (at least 5 years)
3. a contribution that has required substantial and commendable personal input
4. a contribution that can be clearly documented and corroborated.

Nominations are accepted at any stage during the year and the review process takes a round 6 months. You will receive acknowledgement of your nomination in writing within 14 days of its receipt.

Max Gardner AM was a passionate advocate for cancer support services and a devoted and enthusiastic leader of the Prostate Cancer movement. Those of us involved in the early days of Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia and Prostate Cancer Support Groups have been inspired to pursue Max's vision since his death in October 2004 to reduce the impact of prostate cancer on Australian men, their partners, families and the community.

Max founded the St Vincent's Prostate Cancer Support Group in 1996. In December 2003 he became Chair of PCFA having been chair of its Support & Advocacy Committee since June 2001. Max, who was born in New Zealand, received an Honorary AM in July 2002.
